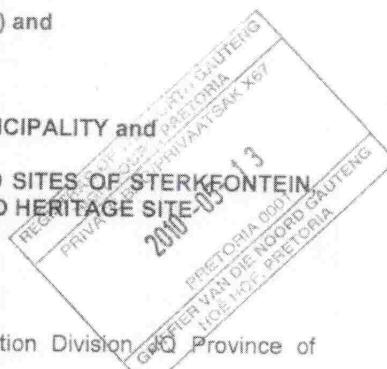

ORDER OF COURT

By agreement between the Applicant and the First, Second Third and Fifth

Respondents the following order is made:

1. The First Respondent is ordered to take steps to prevent as far as possible any unauthorised person or persons from entering or accessing the property known as Portion 26 of the Farm Kromdraai 520, Registration Division JQ, Gauteng Province (hereinafter 'Portion 26') with the aim of taking up residence thereat unless in terms of all applicable laws, by-laws and regulations that may pertain to Portion 26.
2. The steps to be taken by the First Respondent as contemplated in paragraph 1 above, shall include:

2.1 The First Respondent is to erect a secure fence on that part of the perimeter of Portion 26 which is not at present fenced, being in the vicinity of the Kromdraai Cash Store on the Kromdraai Road, together with one or more gates therein;

2.2 The First Respondent is to restrict as far as possible, access to Portion 26 to the gate(s) referred to in paragraph 2.1 above; and shall, for that purpose, at least post a sufficient number of guards at the area referred to in paragraph 2.1 above, so as to prevent, as far as possible,

2.3 The First Respondent is to post a guard at each of the gate(s) referred to in paragraph 2.1 above; any unauthorised person or persons from entering or accessing Portion 26 with the aim of taking up residence thereat.

2.4 The First Respondent is to:

2.4.1 assign numbers to each dwelling on Portion 26 that appears to be occupied;

2.4.2 establish the name or names of the principal inhabitant or inhabitants of each dwelling as identified in paragraph 2.4.1 above who are prepared to identify themselves;

2.4.3 compile a register of all of the present inhabitants of Portion 26, reflecting therein:

2.4.3.1 in respect of those inhabitants of the dwelling(s) who are prepared to identify themselves, their name(s) and the assigned number of their dwelling(s).

2.4.3.2 in respect of those inhabitants of the dwelling(s) who are not prepared to identify themselves, the assigned number of their dwelling(s) and the number of inhabitants of the dwelling(s).

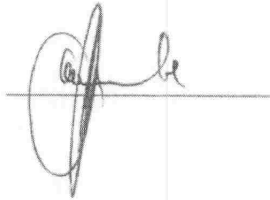

- 2.5.1 Update the register on or about the first day of each month, and
- 2.5.2 provide a copy of the said register to attorney Herman van der Merwe & Greyling upon request.
- 2.6 The First Respondent is to post a notice at the gate(s) referred to in paragraph 2.1 above in English as well as in any one or more of the other official languages of the Republic that are spoken by the present inhabitants of Portion 26 in accordance with the wording of annexure "X" hereto.
- 3 Until such time as Portion 26 has been fenced in as set out in paragraph ~~and also after the fence had been erected~~ 2.1 above, the First Respondent is to post a sufficient number of guards at that part of the perimeter of Portion 26 which is not at present fenced so as to prevent, as far as possible, any unauthorised person or persons from entering or accessing Portion 26 with the aim of taking up residence thereat.
- 4 The First Respondent is to remove all dwellings at Portion 26 that do not appear to be occupied, including those ~~part~~ partially completed.

5. The Second, Third and Fifth Respondents are to take all such steps as are in their power to ensure that the First Respondent complies with the provisions of this order.
6. The Applicant is granted leave to approach the Court on the same papers, supplemented where necessary for relief should any of the First, Second and Fifth Respondents fail to comply with the terms of this order.
7. Costs are reserved.
8. This order shall not be construed as an admission by First, Second and Fifth Respondents that the Applicant has the necessary *locus standi* to institute and prosecute this application.
